

Do You or Your Spouse Qualify for Additional Financial Support for Your Service to Our Country?



If you or your spouse served at least 90 days of active duty, with at least one day during a qualified war period, you may be eligible for the Veterans Aid & Attendance Pension.

Qualified War Periods

World War II

Dec. 7, 1941 -
Dec. 31, 1946

Korean War

June 27, 1950 -
Jan. 31, 1955

Vietnam War

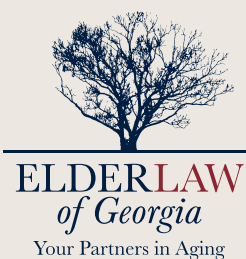
Nov. 5, 1955 -
May 7, 1975*

Persian Gulf War

Aug. 2, 1990
& Ongoing

*Between Nov. 5, 1955 and Aug. 5, 1964 must have had feet on the ground in Vietnam for at least 90 days. From Aug. 6, 1964-May 7, 1975 did not have to physically be in country to qualify.
